to perform improvements at the middle school to include, but not be limited to: acquire and install and/or fix and/or repair the carpet and tile floor coverings, acquire and install guttering, and acquire and apply paint on the exterior walls	\$139,000.00

to perform improvements at the gymnasium to include, but not be limited to: restore the gym floor and acquire and install seating	\$60,000.00
to acquire and/or install textbooks and technology equipment	\$50,000.00
to acquire band instruments	\$10,000.00
to acquire commercial mowing equipment	\$10,000.00
