STUDENT ACTIVITIES SCHOLASTIC ELIGIBILITY

Ringwood High School requires grade checks which are made on the Thursdays of each week following the 3rd week of the nine-week grading period. If a student is failing a class or classes, he/she is advised of his/her situation. The student will be placed on eligibility probation. If at the end of the following week the student is failing any class, the student becomes ineligible beginning the Monday and is ineligible until Sunday at Midnight. Once a student is ineligible he/she will not be allowed to participate in any extracurricular school activity until he/she becomes eligible again. Students that are ineligible for two consecutive weeks may be required to attend extra learning opportunities as decided by the administration. This may include morning/lunch/afternoon required tutoring sessions.

NOTE:

In compliance with the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act, under no circumstances should student eligibility or ineligibility lists be publicly posted in any manner.
